Enamel markings may be caused by one or more of the following:

1. Tooth darkening caused by a tooth injury
2. Tooth darkening caused by medications or medical conditions either in the patient or in their birth mother.



These problems are both corrected with restorations at your general dental office.

3. Staining on the teeth



This problem is corrected with a cleaning after treatment with your dentist.

4. General yellowing of the enamel



This problem can be improved with bleaching. Ask us how you can use bleach in your retainers!

5. Discolorations in your enamel that were present when the teeth erupted. Typically white or rust in color, this condition can be treated with MI Paste!

6. Scaring caused by too much plaque in certain areas either prior to orthodontic treatment or during orthodontic treatment. Any food left around your braces after eating will begin to turn into plaque within 48 hours. Plaque is acidic and immediately begins eating into the surface of the enamel. Typically white in color, this condition can be treated with MI Paste!

5 treatments are completed in the office. These treatments are completed every 3 months and include an intense etching of the discolored areas of the teeth, followed by professional application of MI Paste.



Patients are responsible for nightly application of their MI Paste in their retainers. Failure to apply MI Paste consistently will lessen the desired effect.
